



SCHOOL RULES

Respect for the School

- Keep the school clean at all times
- Do not throw trash on the floor—use the trash cans
- Treat classrooms, hallways, bathrooms, and common areas with respect

Respect for Teachers & Staff

- Listen immediately when a teacher gives instructions
- Speak politely and respectfully at all times
- Do not argue, raise your voice, or walk away without permission
- Teachers have the right to mention anything to the administration

Respect for Fellow Students

- Speak kindly to others—no teasing, bullying, or hurtful words
- Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself
- Help younger students and be a good role model

Islamic Manners (Akhlaq)

- Say Assalamu Alaikum when meeting anyone
- Use Islamic manners in speech, behavior, and interaction
- Do not shout, push, or run inside the building
- Keep your appearance clean and neat at all times





Classroom Rules

- Be on time to every class
- Bring your binders, books, laptops, and pencils to each class
- No talking when the teacher is talking
- Raise your hand before speaking
- Do your classwork and homework properly and on time

Hallway & Staircase Rules

- Walk, do not run, in hallways
- Do not disturb other classes by talking or entering without permission
- Follow teacher instructions for movement between classes

Personal Devices & Phone Policy

- Phones or any personal electronic devices are strictly not allowed in school without **prior** permission from the administration
- If a phone or any unauthorized device is found, it will be immediately confiscated
- The device will only be returned directly to the parent, not to the student
- Repeated violations may result in additional disciplinary action

Food & Eating Rules

- Eat only in designated areas (on a tarp)
- Do not bring food to classrooms
- Keep eating areas clean for others



Uniform & Appearance

- Wear the Islamic clothes properly every day
- No messy or untidy appearance
- No human or animal images are allowed on any clothing

Girls' Uniform:

- Hijab must cover the chest and back completely, not be see-through, and be securely pinned (no loose or slipping hijabs)
- Girls must wear either a long dress that reaches close to the knees, or a closed-front abaya (not open from the front)
- Clothing must not be tight or form-fitting

Boys' Uniform:

- Boys should wear a thobe or a traditional Islamic dress that reflects modesty and cleanliness
- Kufi (Islamic hat) is mandatory for older boys

Salaah Etiquettes

- Make Wudhu
- Line up quietly for Salaah
- Pray with focus, respect, and stillness





Safety Rules

- Follow all safety instructions
- Report any unsafe behavior to a teacher immediately

Honesty & Responsibility

- No lying, cheating, or taking others' belongings
- Take responsibility for your actions
- Return lost items to a teacher

Behaviors that are strictly prohibited:

- Bringing non-Islamic ideas or practices, such as improper relationships, inappropriate media, music, or trends
- Using bad language, swearing, or disrespectful speech toward teachers or students
- Improper physical interaction, including:
 - Rough physical behavior
 - Touching others in a way that is inappropriate
 - Sitting on each other or any behavior that violates personal boundaries
- Any behavior that disrupts the Islamic environment

Any student engaging in these behaviors will be addressed immediately, parents will be informed, and corrective steps will be taken according to the school's disciplinary policy.
